KUEBLER WALDRIP HAUS & DANVILLE SCHOOLHOUSE BED & BREAKFAST

In 1974, when the Waldrip family purchased the property that became the Kuebler Waldrip Haus B & B, they were only the third family to occupy the house since Andreas and Katherine Pape built it in 1847. Today, it is one of the most outstanding bed and breakfasts in Texas. Larry and Margaret and their three sons—Dibrell, Darrell and David—created a place that guests describe as “magical and restful.” Perfectly located on 43 relaxing Hill Country acres just minutes from the Guadalupe and Comal rivers, Schlitterbahn, entertainment in historic New Braunfels and Gruene, Margaret and her son, Darrell operate the Kuebler Waldrip Haus, which is absolutely perfect for getaways, vacations, church and corporate retreats, family reunions, and weddings.

Relax and enjoy the wildlife and pet cats, the sweet country air, the history of the buildings, and the hospitality of this delightful family. Guests vow that the breakfasts are “the best in Texas” and are worth the trip themselves. Scrumptious egg dishes, delectable sausage, fresh fruit, fluffy biscuits, and decadent cinnamon rolls are regulars at their table.

Accommodations sleep 22-34 in three luxuriously restored and enlarged buildings. The Kuebler Waldrip Haus, an 1847 hand-hewn



limestone homestead has fireplaces, five lovely bedrooms and five baths. Recycled rocks from a local church and the Comal County Jail made beautiful additions. The 1863 Danville Schoolhouse features the original chalkboard and wood floors. With four bedrooms, five baths, large meeting room, kitchen, piano and 48” TV with VCR/DVD, this building is perfect for group events. And, Deer Haven Cottage is a cozy three-bedroom cottage named for Angel (the pet deer) that insisted on standing right in the middle of the old barn’s restoration.
